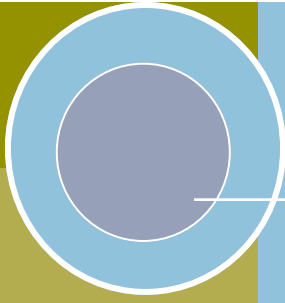

**Are there other similar conferences? The Fall Forum provides the only convening opportunity for cancer patient navigators in the state of Kentucky.**

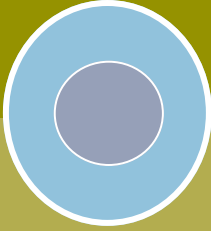
