Cooper Clayton Method to Stop Smoking: What’s next?

Determining optimal smoking cessation for patients with lung, head and neck cancers

- Also known as the MOST project. Funding has been approved and hope to begin research soon!
- Focuses on identifying which evidence-based interventions work best for patients with lung, head and neck cancers

CMS initial decision and implications for Lung Cancer Screening

- Final decision will be made in November 2014 or February 2015
- Lung Cancer Alliance is advocating for the final decision to be different. See link to press release: <http://www.lungcanceralliance.org/news/lung-cancer-alliance-news/2014/lca-reiterates-support-for-full-medicare-coverage-of-screening.html>
- They reviewed the same data as USPSTF and USPSTF gave it a B while Medicare recommended not approving coverage
- Seem to be holding lung cancer screening to a different standard than other screenings
