- Potential Policies:
 - Tobacco Tax/ Tax Reform
 - There will be a lot of opportunity for education around the benefits of a tobacco tax. It will be important to emphasize that it must be at least \$1 to be effective.
 - Tobacco Cessation Bill
 - Local Smoke-free – this is an important area of focus in the current environment.
 - Radon
 - Lawsuit continues to hold up legislation
 - Required Radon testing in Daycares
- LCN Toolkit – Almost final!
- Self-Made Health Network Grant (please see fact sheet)
 - 8 counties in the study – focus is on men and worksites
 - Focus groups throughout November
 - Potential for potential polices (“little P”) around Tobacco-free and radon awareness
