

## **REVIEW OF PARTNER TOOL**

- PARTNER stands for:
  - Program to Analyze, Record, and Track Networks to Enhance Relationships
  - Based on network theory and Social Network Analysis (SNA) to measure & evaluate collaborative relationships
    - How organizations interact with one another
    - What resources do they share? What resources do they need?
       Measures the strength and number of ties/connectivity (or relationships) to determine how connected they are in the network
    - Provides evidence to funders that collaboration/activities are occurring
- Is an online survey tool

### WHAT CAN THIS SURVEY SHOW US?

- We are part of a network or collaborative= Kentucky Cancer Consortium (KCC)
- We want to gather data about how we work together beyond the "Who is Doing What" survey
- Although first implemented in June/July 2012, the participation rate was small (39%)- we would like at least 75% of our organizations participating
- It helps if you participate b/c other organizations will be naming you as a partner

## WHAT CAN THIS SURVEY SHOW US-SPECIFICALLY?

- Key indicators of networks
  - Membership representation
  - Resource Inventory
  - Outcomes
  - Successes/Accomplishments
  - What aspects of collaboration have contributed to this success?
  - Organizations you partner with (shows how organizations "network", their diversity & number)
     Type of work you do together & how often you work together
    - Power & Influence
    - · Level of Involvement (participation level/commitment)
  - Resource contribution
    Mission congruence
    Open to discussion/trust in relationships

  - Policy, law and/or regulation

#### 8) Level of Success

- How successful has the KCC Collaborative been at making progress towards its goals & objectives?
- 9) Contributing Factors toward this success
  - What aspects of the collaborative contribute to success?
     Bringing together diverse stakeholders
    - Meeting regularly 4x/year
    - Informal relationships created
    - Exchanging information/knowledge

## QUESTION 10 SELECTING ORGANIZATIONS

10)You will select the organizations from a list with whom you interact (either formally or informally)

- You will not see your own organization listed (you are unable to collaborate with yourself)
- The next 8 questions will focus on your working relationship with the organizations you pick

#### 11) Frequency of work with this organization(s)

- 12)Kinds of activities you perform with this organization(s)
- None

## QUESTIONS 13-18 NETWORK INDICATORS

- How valuable is this organization(s) in achieving the overall mission of the KCC?
  - 13) Power & Influence
  - 14) Level of Involvement/Committed and active
  - Resource contribution (\$, information, data, other resources)
  - 16) Reliability (follow-up)
  - 17) Mission congruence (Shares common vision of the end goal)
  - 18) Open to discussion/trust

## OPTIONAL QUESTIONS

- No optional questions will be asked on the survey this year
- Next year's evaluation plan for "Partnership" may include a survey or key informant questions
